How Important is Your Child's Attendance?

Attending school regularly & on time helps children feel better about school—and themselves. Good attendance helps children do well in high school, college, and at work.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Starting in kindergarten, too many absences can cause children to fall behind in school.
- Missing 10 percent (or about 18 days) negatively impacts academic achievement.
- Students fall behind if they miss just a day or two days every few weeks.
- Being late to school makes it hard to stay on track.
- Absences & late arrivals affect & disrupt the learning process for all students.


