

### **What is the Read to ME Challenge?**

The *Read to ME Challenge* is an opportunity to contribute to a child's literacy growth by reading aloud to one or more children for at least 15 minutes. We are hoping to get 100% participation from our Lamoine Consolidated Families! We've even shared a book with our K-2 families to make it super easy. Follow these easy steps to complete the challenge.

### **Steps for Taking the Read to ME Challenge**

- Read to and/or have a child/children read to you for at least 15 minutes.
- Capture a photograph or short video (15-30 seconds) of yourself reading to the child.
- Sign the Read to ME in Lamoine confirmation and return it to school.
- You can also use **#ReadtoME** or **#ReadaloudME** to post the photo or video on social media with your challenge to others to read aloud 15 minutes to a child or children they know.

Drama practice will now be held on Thursdays from 3:00-4:00. **Please note the change in ending time from 4:30 to 4:00.**


Please make sure that your child wears a winter coat, snow pants, hat and mittens each day so that he or she can enjoy fresh air and exercise at recess!
