
*Summer Gardening
Opportunity!*

The University of Maine Cooperative Extension is again offering "Kids Can Grow," a gardening program for 7-12 year-olds. Children come to five monthly sessions held at Maine Coast Heritage Trust in Somesville. After each session they practice what they have learned in a 3'x5' raised bed at their home under the guidance of a mentor who visits regularly. A \$25 fee covers supplies, including seeds, plants, and the lumber and loam for the raised bed at home. Class sessions are held from 4:00 to 6:00 the first Tuesday of the month: May 3, June 7, July 5, Aug. 2 and Sept. 6. There is a parent/child orientation on Tuesday April 26 from 5:15 – 6:30.
