How it came to be.....

The beautiful new playground is a wonderful example of community spirit and collaboration. The playground improvement project has been ongoing for several years. This past spring the funding was finally attained through private donation, local funding, with the largest portion coming from our PATRONS group.

You might wonder how our PATRONS group came to have these funds. Sadly, in 2005 Lamoine student and resident, Jina Haslam, was tragically killed when she was struck by a car while riding her bike along Route 184. Over the course of the next 5 years, a group of residents worked tirelessly to raise money in an effort to build a new gymnasium. In 2010 our gymnasium was renovated and rededicated as "Jina's Gym" in her memory. The remaining raised funds were distributed for worthy causes including the YMCA, a scholarship fund, and PATRONS.

Our PATRONS group was given the responsibility of using the funds in a way that honored Jina's memory. We are honored and grateful that our playground was chosen as such a worthy cause. Thank you!
