- May be printed in July with an appropriate cost of \$10 a copy.
- We still need to figure out a distribution plan to give interested residents free copies (one per household). Possibly we could set up a couple of times when people could come pick one up from us some place in town instead of the Town Hall.
- Copies will be given to local libraries.

“We Are the Parade”

- The big parade originally scheduled for this year will be held on August 14, 2021 along with fireworks that evening. Cynthia will contact involved parties to let them know of the date.
- If we are going to do a video parade this year, we need to find an available professional videographer.
- The parade may consist of firetrucks, decorated cars, and perhaps bicycles.
- The parade would go through the school parking lot to be filmed without spectators.

- Miranda has the T-shirt order ready to go.
- We still need to use the sardine label. Perhaps it could be included in our sardine poster.
