The Lamoine Board of Appeals has received, via e-mail, an appeal of an alleged action by the Code Enforcement Officer in regard to a complaint filed by Thomas True. Mr. True has alleged that the Code Enforcement Officer has failed to enforce a “violation of the Building and Land Use Ordinance”.

Due to the current state of emergency declared both by the State of Maine and by the Lamoine Board of Selectmen, all in person board meetings are canceled until further notice. The emergency makes it impossible for the Board of Appeals to meet at this time to consider the preliminary merits of the application.

The Appeals Board will indefinitely postpone any required deadlines in regard to the receipt of the appeal which might be imposed as of April 15, 2020. Once the emergency is lifted, the Board will schedule and notify all parties of a meeting time and place to consider the appeal.
