

Lamoine Comprehensive Planning Committee Minutes
March 29, 2018

(Revisions, April 26, 2018)

1. Meeting called to order by Fred Stocking at 6:30. Those in attendance were Fred, Mike, Bob, Kathie, Val, and Wanda. Absent Andrea and Richard.

2. 2. Consideration of minutes from March 8: Two changes to be made: #7 - Date of next meeting change from April 29 to March 29th. # 8: time of adjourning to 7:45 not 10:45. The minutes were accepted as written with two changes. Mike and Kathie moved and seconded. Approved 6:0.

3. GIS Mapping ~ Fred shared a conversation he had with Elaine Eaton, who teaches at U.M.M, and Larissa Thomas, chair of LCC, Tora Johnson, one of her students, would like to do a Lamoine-based project. They proposed to do GIS-mapping of Lamoine: To show wetlands and areas of potential "migration" of those wetlands as they become submerged over time, and 2.) To show sea level rise and storm surge threats to Lamoine's infrasture. Fred also explained that we are not obligated to use them if we are not satisfied.

Mike shared that he would only like the maps to be used as a reference. He also explained that some of the layers of the Beginning with Habitat Maps are not accessible, but Fred stated that he will discuss this with Tora and believes she must already have this data to do what she has done already.

Mike made a motion to have Tora Johnson and college student, Elaine, proceed with the mapping. Valerie Seconded. Approved 6:0.

4. Looked at a table, *List of Maps and Tables Needed*, produced by Fred. Had a discussion about maps that are still needed for each section. Fred and Kathy will get together to work on maps that are still needed.

Fred will reword text for History & Archaeology instead of including maps.

5. Next Steps:

- a. Fred will write a draft of the Introduction and send along to Kathy to review and then send along to the rest of the committee.
- b. Wanda will write a history of the efforts we made to gather opinions from townspeople.
- c. Bob & Val will look at what goals are being worked on already.
- d. Mke will work with Stu to get a list of Town roads and their conditions, as well as a map of them.

6. Discussed Top Ten Priorities for the town by looking at Goals and Strategies. We Individually ranked the priorities, and decided to continue our discussion at the next meeting.
