2. Amanda Frost recommended to the Selectman for appointment as an alternate member of the Recreation Committee.
3. Reviewed: Cheering and basketball programs. Cheering: had 3 events, 2 spirit awards and 1st in division in State. Ellsworth Cheering mats may be available. Practice space an issue. Early Nov. start. Maybe expand to 2 groups next year. 15 girls participated..half from Lamoine and half from MDI. Discussion of fees for out of town participants..no decision to change current policy. Should plan for new uniforms about every 3-4 years. Discussion of coaching remuneration . DECISION: All coaches shall receive fee waiver for all children in that season. Gift card and Thank You.
4. Discussion about registration process based on indoor soccer registration. Numbers were down but then everyone began to show up late. Three things decided. A. We should firm up registration date and not take late entries ( with exceptions for cause). B. All participants of our programs get a t-shirt, certificate of Participation, a medal and team picture. C. That when the certificates are handed out, there is a registration form and information for the next program, with pertinent information. We should decide wether PK/K programs should be offered as part of our participation with the Y or should there just be informal programs at that level. We should recommend that Y leagues have at least 2 weeks between, fall soccer should end mid Oct. too dark. Next year we should not have our indoor soccer program play games at our gym.. too small.
