Recreation Committee Meeting Minutes

1. Call to Order

Meeting was called to order at 6:36 PM

2. Review and Approve Minutes from 4/4/2019

Minutes were not available, so they will be reviewed and approved next month.

3. Fall Soccer

Nikki re-introduced Mark Woida who had visited a rec meeting in late fall to discuss an opportunity for collaboration during soccer season. Mark described that he is looking for a partnership in order to create a league who will play all games at the same time, and have all levels play at the same location throughout the season (on a rotating basis). He discussed the pros of this type of league, as it is a league that the MDI teams had run several years in the past. Committee members discussed that this model would be especially appealing for parents who had multiple athletes at multiple age levels. Further details were discussed, including a date range that does mesh with the DEFY league (so that supplemental scrimmages can be scheduled if needed), and Mark agreed to draft up a schedule to provide to the committee to approve ASAP for the fall.

Motion to work with Mark Woida in collaboration with MDI soccer teams for Fall 2019 was made by Michelle Stoll, and seconded by Ashley Mawhinney.
