Recreation Committee Meeting Minutes

1. Call to Order

Meeting was called to order at 6:28 PM

2. Fall Soccer

The registration event that was held directly before the meeting was a huge success. The event was held in the LCS Gym due to weather, but attendance was high. Donations of popsicles were made by Rec members to the cause.

To begin, the committee reflected upon the event, and then discussed the option of doing some research about an online registration process. Acadia Youth Sports allows for online registration and it seems to be successful. Ashley Mawhinney asked questions regarding the needs for a site - she said she will do some research and will bring information back at a future meeting (pricing, site upkeep, etc.).

Nikki Chan then shared an update regarding Acadia Fire (AF) and the use of Lamoine fields. Due to a limited use of LCS fields by AF this year, the committee will need to rent a portapotty for the site, as well as look into purchasing their own nets. Nikki told the committee that she would take care of both of these tasks. She noted she will reach out to Wallace Events to rent the potty, and ask Perry Fowler to pump it on a regular basis. Nikki volunteered Victor Chan to research and order the nets through Stu Marckoon at the Town Office.

Motion to purchase new nets and rent portapotties in support of the fall soccer program was made by Deanne Cray at 7:14 PM, and seconded by Patti Haslam.

The committee then took the time to organize and count the registration papers from the event. 11 PK/K athletes were registered, followed by 21 1/2 athletes, and 28 3/4/5 athletes. Finally, the committee discussed the sheer size of the



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3/4/5 team. It was decided that Nikki would reach out to Melissa and Damon Johnson (existing coaches) to get their thoughts on next steps, splitting up the team, etc..

3. Rec Shed

Nikki reported that Stu Marckoon had reached out to connect about the shed. He said that as it turns out, the shed near the Anderson Garage was not worth saving/fixing due to animal damage and disrepair. She hadn't connected back with him, but will do so soon to decide upon next steps for proper Rec equipment care and longevity.

6. Other Items

Finally, Nikki filled the committee in about a community member, Michael Lynch, who reached out and would like to have a discussion regarding a donation he would like to make of the funds for a basketball court somewhere in town in memory of his Late wife. The committee discussed several options for ideal placement of the court. It was decided that Nikki will connect back with Stu and possibly Cynthia Donaldson who already has a local project going on at Lamoine Beach with the Lamoine's Little Children Committee in order to set up a meeting with Mr. Lynch.
