4. Fall Soccer

Nikki recapped the final schedules for the soccer season, including the scheduled (one) game for the PK/K team. Nikki also volunteered to complete the certificates for all of the teams and get them to coaches before the last game. Andrea volunteered to pick up the team photos from Walgreens and assemble them in clear bags to give to athletes at the last game with their certificates.

Melissa mentioned that when she lived in New Jersey athletes received patches at the end of the season. It was a fun little treat - kids then ended up trading patches over time with fellow athletes. The committee noted it was a great idea and could look into it for another year (not enough time at this point to order them - Melissa agreed).



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5. Cheering Program Update

Nikki updated the committee about the email from Jenny Saunders announcing her resignation as coach of the program. The committee then discussed options for running a program this season. The group decided that they will spread the word on facebook and through word of mouth about the need for a coach, and would ideally like to take a more developmental and skills-based approach for this year. This would mean there would be less of an emphasis on competition and more of an emphasis on skills (tumbling, etc.) and FUN. Ideally, the season will run during the same calendar time as basketball.

Nikki also noted she would reach out to Jenny regarding the uniforms that were used by K-2 Lamoine Rec Cheering in the past.

6. Basketball Needs

The committee discussed needs to get basketball up and running for the season, mainly identifying coaches for each team. Ashley Mawhinney would like to continue as 3/4/5 coach again this year. Nikki noted she would reach out to Aaron Brown and see if he would be willing to coach PK/K again. Deanne let the committee know that she would not be able to coach 1/2 this year as her children have aged out of that level and she is very busy, so the committee identified Eric Rollins as a parent within the age level as a possible coach. Nikki volunteered to reach out to Eric to ask.

The committee also reviewed the schedule and programs for PK-2 which run through the DEFY league, and for 3-5 which run through the AYS league. The committee would like to continue with both programs as they did/were last year. Nikki will be the main contact for information dissemination to and from AYS as well as DEFY.
