Request for Bids Street Sweeping/Sand Removal

The Town of Lamoine is requesting sealed bids for street & parking lot sweeping and winter sand removal services for the years 2019 through 2021. Bidders are requested to fill out and return the form on the next page and submit it to the Road Commissioner by 4:00 PM on Thursday, April 25, 2019 at 606 Douglas Highway, Lamoine, ME 04605. The bids will be opened and read aloud at the Selectmen's meeting that evening. It is anticipated the bid will be awarded at that time, but the Town of Lamoine reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids. Sweeping services are to be completed between May 1 and May 31 of each applicable year. The following roads and parking lots are to be swept clear of winter sand buildup, and intersections where buildup in the shoulders is higher than the road travel surface shall be cleared of the buildup to a level the same as the travel surface:
