## Lamoine 150! Time Capsules Contents and Location

Two metal time capsules are located in the Lamoine Town Hall Vault in the top drawer of a two drawer locking fireproof file cabinet. These are to be opened in 2045 (the town's 175<sup>th</sup> birthday celebration). They are sealed with a bolt that is opened by an allen wrench and a nut to be held by a wrench. Two sets of tools are in the drawer with the time capsules. The capsules were packed on October 29, 2021.
