Lamoine Volunteer Training Offered

(Lamoine) The Lamoine Committee on Aging is inviting residents of Lamoine and surrounding towns to a Volunteer Training in Lamoine on Wednesday, February 28 at 1:00 at the Lamoine Town Hall. People who are interested in helping their neighbors with grocery deliveries and rides to medical appointments should attend. Individual training is also availability for anyone not able to attend on that date.

The training will be offered by Friends in Action, a 501 c 3 nonprofit that provides transportation and other services at no charge to residents of Hancock County. Trained volunteers provide a variety of services, primarily transportation and deliveries of food and medicine. Each volunteer can stipulate their availability, including the town where they volunteer. Volunteers always have discretion as to whether they accept a request.

Through Friends in Action, volunteers receive ongoing support and training and are covered with volunteer insurance. Requests for services are coordinated through the Friends in Action office.

The Lamoine Committee on Aging has identified an interest among Lamoine residents in helping their neighbors with transportation and other resources. The Lamoine Town Hall is located at 606 Douglas Highway.
