Minutes – April 13, 2024

Chair Jeff Cosulich called the meeting to order at 1:02 PM.

Present were: Parks Commissioners Jeff Cosulich, Bob Ehlers, Karen Davis, Oliver Curry, Em Whitney, Alternate Georgianna Pulver.

Meeting took place at Lamoine Beach Park. Report back from Bob Ehlers and Oliver Curry that it was impossible to manually remove grills by hand, McMullen will remove. Concerns of the meeting were to determine the placement of trash cans/new grills/new picnic tables made by Ehlers/the location of boat launch and/or driveway removal.

Lamoine Beach Update:

-A motion to confirm the removal of the driveway would take place up to the existing concrete barriers and signage, to replace the concrete barriers with large boulders, to leave 8ft for a vehicle to get through, and to add reflective paint that adheres to standards of dead-end roadways at the end of the existing boat launch.

Motion passes unanimously

-A motion to place new tables and new grills on the north side of the parking lot where the bike rack is, in an attempt to address sea level rise and its impact on the picnic area. The motion included the addition of 2 restrictive trash cans there and one by the bathroom.

Motion passes unanimously

-Motion is made authorizing Davis up to \$1500 for the purchase of 3 restrictive trash cans.

Motion passes unanimously, but was put on hold until further discussion of trash can types can take place at the next meeting.

There is a crack in the Jambette children's structure, members agreed to check on the warranty and then move forward with more information.

Marlboro Beach Update:

Issues with continued storms and storm debris, along with drivers driving onto the muck and making issues worse, inform ideas of blocking driving access and including conservation group in the discussion.

Motion to adjourn passed at 1:51
