PLEASE NOTE

A **signed** request by the voter or a member of the voter’s immediate family (received as an original or by fax) is sufficient for the municipal clerk to issue an absentee ballot by mail or in person to the voter or to the immediate family member making the request, or to a 3rd person designated on the application by the voter. An immediate family member is not considered a 3rd person, but should sign in place of the voter, and must indicate the family relationship. If an immediate family member takes the ballot to the voter, and a different immediate family member returns the ballot to the clerk, the clerk should have the second family member sign underneath the first on the application. **A 3RD PERSON CANNOT BE A CANDIDATE OR MEMBER OF A CANDIDATE’S IMMEDIATE FAMILY.**
