

Town Meeting Warrant
Town of Lamoine State of Maine

Greetings:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the voters of the Town of Lamoine, in said county, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Lamoine Town office in said town on Tuesday, June 11, 2019 at 7:55 AM then and there to act on articles 1 through 5, all of said articles being set out below, to wit:

1. To choose a moderator to preside over said meeting.
2. To vote by secret ballot referendum on the following question: "Do you favor approving the Lamoine School Department budget for the upcoming school year that was adopted at the latest Lamoine School Department budget meeting?"
3. To vote by secret ballot referendum on the following question: "Do you wish to continue the budget validation referendum for the Lamoine School Department for an additional three years?" A "YES" vote will require the Lamoine School Department to continue to conduct a referendum to validate its annual school budget for the next three year. A "NO" vote will discontinue the budget validation referendum for at least three years and provide instead that the annual school budget shall be finally adopted at a meeting of the voters of Lamoine.
4. To vote by secret ballot referendum on the following, non-binding advisory question: Should the Board of Selectmen pursue participation in the Municipal Partnership Initiative with the Maine Department of Transportation where the town would pay up to \$500,000 to help rebuild portions of State Route 184 and/or Route 204?
5. To vote by secret ballot referendum on the following, non-binding advisory question: Should the Board of Selectmen seek proposals to utilize the town property (Map 1 Lot 58) at the now closed and capped landfill for production of solar energy?

The voting on Articles 2, 3, 4 and 5 shall be by secret ballot referendum and the polls shall be opened immediately after the election of the moderator at 8:00 A.M. and closed at 8:00 P.M. The Registrar of Voters will hold office hours while the polls are open to correct any error in or change a name or address on the voting list, to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote, and to accept new enrollments. A person who is not registered as a voter may not vote in any election.
