## Minutes of Special Town Meeting November 7, 2019

Deputy Town Clerk Stuart Marckoon called the meeting to order at the Lamoine Town Hall at 7:00 PM.

Present were approximately 40-voters.

**Article 1 To choose a moderator to preside over said meeting.** – Selectman S. Josephine Cooper nominated Gary McFarland to be the moderator. Selectman Nathan Mason 2<sup>nd</sup>. There were no other nominations from the floor. The deputy clerk collected written ballots from those who chose to vote, and 15 ballots were cast for Mr. McFarland. No other ballots were cast. Deputy Clerk Marckoon administered the oath of office to Mr. McFarland.

**Article 2 - To see if the town will authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into an agreement with SunPower Corporation to lease municipally owned property for the purposes of constructing and operating a solar energy project under terms the Board of Selectmen find will be in the best interests of the town.** – Selectman S. Josephine Cooper moved to pass the article. Gordon Donaldson 2<sup>nd</sup>. Resident Nathan Cotts asked how far the 3-phase power line would be extended to accommodate the project and suggested it be extended to Shore Road to create a redundant power loop. Several options were the topic of a brief discussion. Following the end of discussion those gathered voted without dissent in favor of the motion.

There being no other business to conduct, Moderator McFarland declared the special town meeting adjourned at 7:08 PM
